<p>Violation #10. Handwashing sinks, accessible & supplies At the time of inspection observed at handwash sink #2 by serving line clogged . Repair handwash sink .</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5)(d). Handwashing sinks are properly equipped with hand soap, individual disposable towels or hand drying device, and signage; and conveniently located.</p>
<p>Violation #40. Personal cleanliness At the time of inspection observed employee at serving line without a hair restraint . Employees shall wear effective hair restraints. Employee put hair restraint. COS</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(3). Employees shall wear effective hair restraints; clean outer clothing; gloves when nails are artificial, polished, or not trimmed; and not wear prohibited jewelry.</p>
<p>Violation #48. Ware washing: installed, maintained, & used; test strips At the time of inspection observed at three compartments sink wet paper towels . Remove paper towels . Staff removed paper towels. COS</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(4). Warewashing facilities must be approved, available, maintained, effective, and used for cleaning and sanitizing food-contact surfaces and equipment. Test strips are available and used to verify the solution is at a concentration necessary to achieve sanitization.</p>
<p>Violation #54. Garbage & refuse disposal At the time of inspection observed opened dumpster lids. Close lids to prevent harboring of pests.. Staff closed dumpster lids. COS</p> <p>At the time of inspection observed dumpster with broken surfaces (leaking) one of three dumpsters . Replace dumpster</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Garbage shall be disposed of to prevent vector harborage. Trash cans will be durable, cleanable, leak proof, insect and rodent resistant, and non-absorbent. Outside storage area shall be of a smooth, non-absorbent material and sloped to a drain.</p>
<p>Violation #55. Facilities installed, maintained, & clean At the time of inspection observed at walk in freezer flickering light . Replace light .</p> <p>At the time of inspection observed at storage area one ceiling tiles out of place. Fix ceiling tile.</p> <p>At the time of inspection observed at storage room, missing ceiling light cover, lights should be completely recessed or equipped with guards to prevent accidental contact. Provide ceiling cover.</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, durable, easily cleanable, and non-absorbent. Exterior areas shall be kept cleaned.</p>
